Our Covid marshals are visiting hospitality and retail premises at weekends to check compliance with their Covid controls.

The 2023 Boundary Commission Review

The Boundary Commission for England has published its initial proposals for new constituency boundaries. The proposals and maps for the nine English regions have been published on the website.

The eight-week public consultation period has commenced. This will be the first time the public will get a chance to see what their new constituencies might look like, and give the Commission their views on the proposals.
