Tony Griggs chaired the meeting in the absence of Peter Bradbury.

The minutes of the last meeting were accepted as a true record.

Matters Arising

1. The flooring has been done at a cost of £516.
2. The entrance door has been repaired and is now working well.
3. Mike has spoken to Brian Mee regarding the comments made by the Cricket Club about dandelion heads spreading.. The Contractors will speak to the Cricketers and address complaints.
4. Peter and Tony have mended the letters on gable end wall.
5. A CCTV sign has been put on wall just below lettering.
6. All the Chubb fire extinguishers have been removed and stored in Elaine's garage awaiting collection. New ones provided by Midlands Fire Solution Ltd are now installed and the one in the kitchen replaced by a CO2 extinguisher which is more 'up to date'. The Annual Service Agreement will run from August 2016 at a cost of £30/year. Certificate given to Tony to place in noticeboard.
7. Unfortunately Tony is committed to another Race Night this autumn so has offered to run one for us spring 2016.
8. Peter e-mailed plans from Jane Pond and these will be discussed at a later meeting.

Secretary's Report

1. The Sharnford Youth Club, who hired the football pitch and goalposts, have sent us £20 instead of the invoiced £50 with a letter saying they were not happy with the state of the pitch and non existent markings.
2. Dave Butlin, Manager of the Tin Hat Football Club, phoned to say the Club has finished and will no longer require the Sunday pitch.
3. Russell Webster from Broughton Astley FC. e-mailed to ask if there was availability for a Sunday side. Elaine to e-mail and let him know there is if he wants it.
4. We have also had a request from Gravity FC asking for availability for a Sunday side. If Broughton decline we can offer a pitch to Gravity.

Any Other Business

1. It was noted that the lights in the changing rooms are not always switched off after the Croquet Club have used it. Andy asked if we could put sensor switchers in and Mike asked for costs.
2. More gouges in the floor tiles have been noticed. Tony can fill them in and Mike has offered to come to the Youth Club on Monday night and see if he can find out what is causing them.
3. Pat has invited a group of people from the U3A to attend a training session on the Croquet pitch. This will hopefully encourage more people to join the Croquet Club.
4. Tony has taken a booking for an 'End of Year' school party in the pavilion. No charge.
5. The Youth Club has booked a 1 off Monday session during the summer holidays.
