Matters Arising

1. Elaine has spoken with Kingsland Aluminium and they are willing to view the doors when they are next in the area.
2. Floor tile samples have arrived and are as near as possible to the originals. Elaine to contact J & S Flooring for a quote and if acceptable arrange for the work to be carried out asap.
3. Peter has spoken to our ground maintenance people at Woodward's. They will weed, feed and scarify the pitch and grounds in May this year.
4. Jill has offered to deliver 35 Newsletters to the homes at Aston Firs. Tony thought we will need at least another 50 copies to make 1150 total. This will include 19 to the Limes development and a person to deliver them has been found. Tony to contact Lorraine to increase the print run.
